SUBJECT: Purchase of Body Worn Cameras

PURPOSE

Secure Council approval through a Resolution to purchase 5 body worn cameras and associated services from Motorola Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$12,485.

BACKGROUND

The Illinois Safe-T Act, signed into law on February 22, 2021, mandates that all Illinois police departments purchase, train on, and implement body worn cameras to be used by all police officers while on patrol and involved in a law enforcement encounter. This particular section of the act noted that each department's mandate would be based on population of their jurisdiction. The City of Plano's mandated deadline is January of 2025.

In January 2024, the 10 body worn cameras that were purchased at the end of 2023 were integrated into the day to day operations of the patrol division and investigations division of the police department. The total purchase price was approximately \$38,000 and we received \$20,000 in grant funds from the Small, Rural, and Tribal Communities grant program. An analysis has been conducted, and with officers having to wear the cameras to court, investigators having to take them during out of town investigations, and patrol officers needing them for their shifts, we have identified a need to purchase 5 more to be efficient and compliant.

DISCUSSION

In the 6 months we have been using body worn cameras, this form of equipment has been proven to be crucial for our day to day operations as a police department. We have reviewed use of force incidents, reviewed citizen complaints, procured grant funding towards the original purchase, utilized the footage in court proceedings with high evidentiary value, and are able to train our officers based on supervisor review of incidents. Although body worn cameras are now mandated, they have been an essential tool to also contribute to checks and balances of our patrol division.

Our in-car camera systems and the body worn cameras were purchased from Motorola Solutions. We currently have ten (10) body worn cameras and twenty-one (21) employees currently utilize these cameras on a frequent basis. Five (5) more body cameras would allow those cameras not in use to effectively charge up and be ready for the next shift or on a moment's notice. The

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purchase of five (5) more body cameras is a budgeted item under new equipment. This purchase will come with a 1 year warranty. We believe having 15 body worn cameras would allow us to continue to meet the mandate imposed by the Safe-T Act and allow us to maintain continuity of operations when it comes to video recordings of day to day law enforcement encounters.

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY
OF PLANO AND MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS FOR BODY
CAMERAS AND ASSOCIATED SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Plano (hereinafter referred to as the “City”) is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the City of Plano upon approval of the corporate authorities may enter into an Agreement with another party pursuant to Illinois Statute;

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions (hereinafter referred to as “Company”) is a company that sells body worn cameras;

WHEREAS, the City is interested in contracting with the Company for the purchase of five (5) body worn cameras and associated services for an amount not to exceed \$12,485.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plano Corporate Authorities are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the City of Plano to enter into an agreement with Motorola Solutions, for the purchase of the body worn cameras and associated services for continued compliance with the Illinois Safe-T Act..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Plano, Kendall County, Illinois in open meeting assembled as follows:

Section One – Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this resolution as legislative findings.

Section Two – Approval of Agreement

The City hereby approves this Agreement substantially in the form of the Sales Quote attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

Section Three – Authorization and Direction

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized to attest to an Agreement, substantially in the form of the Sales Quote attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such changes therein as shall be approved by the City Attorney and the officials of the City executing the same, their execution thereof to constitute exclusive evidence of their approval to any and all changes or revisions therein from and after the execution and delivery of such Agreement.

Section Four - Other Actions Authorized

The officers, employees and/or agents of the City shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

Section Five - Authorization of Expenditures

The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the expenditure of all costs related to the execution of the agreement, additionally, the City is authorized and directed to allocate and spend all necessary funds to fulfill the requirements of the agreement and of this resolution.

Section Six – Waiver of Bidding Process

To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable to the transactions contemplated hereunder, the same is hereby waived.

Section Seven - Acts of City Officials

That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the City that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

Section Eight - Conflict Clause

That all resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict with the terms of this resolution shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Nine - Passage Clause

That this resolution shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Ten – Saving Clause

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of any other provisions of this resolution, which are hereby declared to be separable.

Section Eleven – Effective Date

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Twelve - Publication

This resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Thirteen - Recording

This resolution shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the City Council of the City of Plano.
